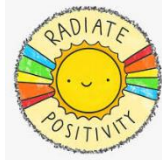

Theme of the Week: International Week!



- **Create** a wreath out of cut outs of your hands. Decorate each hand to represent a flag of a different country. This will represent all of our different countries coming together!

- **Find out more about your own culture!** Interview your family members and discover as much as you can about your culture. Record any new facts that you didn't know already.
- **Think** about the places that you have travelled (or places you would love to travel if you haven't travelled). What was your favourite thing about each place? Are there any places you would want to go back too? Record these in the form of a letter or a diary entry.
- **Learn** how to say 'Hello' in as many languages as you can! Keep practicing all week and get your family members to guess which language you are using each time.
- **Create a Canada Flag!!** Using a white piece of paper and red paint, paint your hand and use it to make the maple leaf in the centre of the flag. If you don't have any paints, create the flag using markers/colouring pencils. Send pictures to your class teacher!
- **Monday 22nd June is St Thomas More's Feast Day.** Your child might enjoy writing an acrostic poem or a prayer to celebrate this day. Do look at the 'Believe, Belong, Become' section of the school website which has more detail and guidance.
