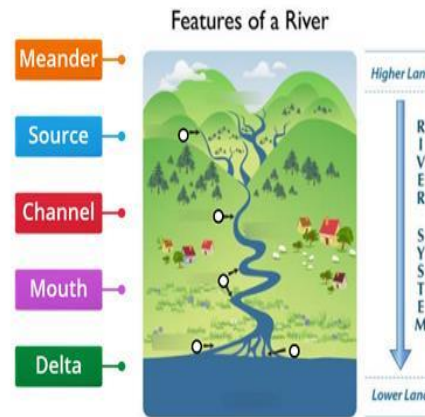
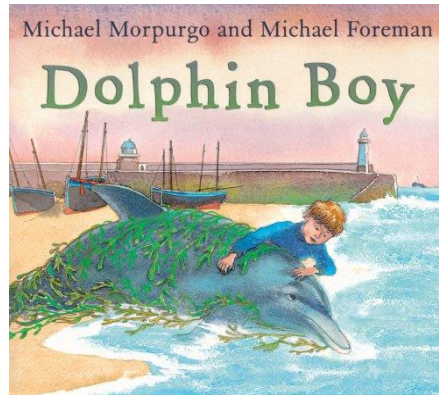


Knowledge Organiser Curriculum Summer Term / Topic: A River's Tale

Vocabulary

Water cycle	The cycle of processes by which water circulates between the earth's oceans.
Evaporation	the process of turning from liquid into vapour.
Condensation	the conversion of a vapour or gas to a liquid.
Source	a place, person, or thing from which something originates or can be obtained
Mouth	The meaning of MOUTH OF THE RIVER is the place where the river enters the ocean

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
