
## Knowledge Organiser Curriculum Summer Term / Topic: A River's Tale

Curriculum Subjects Covered: English, Mathematics, RE, PSHE, History, Geography, Science, PE


Caritas Theme: For Year 5 we are understanding what it means to be an active part of a wider community.

- Step 6: Runoff.
