taken if no symptoms is counted as day 0.

Please see attached an isolation flow chart that shows when to end selfisolation.

With the rise in COVID-19 infections in primary school age children, we encourage you to help limit the spread by testing your child twice-weekly. You can collect Lateral Flow Test kits from your local pharmacy using one of the codes provided Here

Please also note: If you or any member of your family test positive for Covid, there is not a need for your child to isolate. Children only isolate once they test positive

Please do let the school know if you or a family member contract Covid 19, then we can be extra vigilant around the school.
